Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, CIDA Foundation UK gets an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further. This means that £10 can be turned into £12.80 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing.

To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.

Donors who pay a higher rate of income tax can claim the difference between the higher rate of 40% and the basic rate of 22% on the gross amount.

If you pay a lower rate (10% or 20%), we can still claim back 28p for each £1 you donate, provided you pay enough tax to cover the claim. With effect from the tax year 2003/2004, donations can be off-set against any unused tax paid in the previous year.
